



Don't Ask for Punishment in This Life: A Hadith on Seeking Allah's Mercy

I was recently asked about this topic and thought i would share the hadeeth and its subject matter with you.

Upon the authority of Anas ibn Maalik â€‹ Radhiyallahu â€‹ Anhu who said that the Messenger of Allah â€‹ Sallallahu alaihi was Salam visited a man from the Muslims who had become slim and weak and resemblant to a newborn chick (due to an illness). So the Messenger of Allah â€‹ Sallallahu Alaihi Was Sallam said to him: â€‹ **Have you been supplicating for anything or asking him (Allah) for anything?** so he said yes! i have been saying: â€‹ *Oh Allah whatever you were going to punish me with in the hereafter, then give me my punishment in the life of this world*â€‹ so the Messenger of Allah â€‹ Sallallahu Alaihi Was Sallam said: â€‹ **Subhaanallah! You would not withstand that! (or he said) you would not be able! Would it not have been better for you to say â€‹ Oh Allah give me good in the dunya, and good in the hereafter, and save us from the punishment of the Fire**â€‹ then he made dua to Allah for him and Allah cured himâ€‹
