### **The Encouragement to Fast the day of âshârâ**

Taken from âshârâ Sahâh Targhâbâ by Shaykh al-Albani

#### **The Book of Fasting**

##### Chapter to Fast the Day of âshârâ

###### **(1) 1017 Sahâh**

On the Authority of Abu Qatâda (radhiallâhu hu âllâhu anhu): That the Messenger of Allâh (i-â) was asked about the fast of the day of âshârâ , so he answered: âllâha It expiates the sins of the previous year.â

Narrated by Muslim and other than him, and by Ibn Mâjah and his wording is: âllâha The fast of the day of âshârâ ; Indeed the reward that I request from Allâh is that He expiates the sins of the year before this year.â

###### **(2) 1018 Sahâh**

On the authority of Ibn âshârâ Abbâs (radhiallâhu hu âllâhu anhu): That the Messenger of Allâah (i-â) fasted the day of âshârâ , and he ordered for it to be

fasted.

Narrated by Bukhārī and Muslim

(3) 1019 **Sahāh**

On the authority of Ibn Abbās (radiallāh hu ʿanhu), who was asked about the fast of the day of Āshār, so he answered: **I do not know of the Messenger of Allāh (i·ṣ) fasting a day, wanting the excellence of that fast above that of other days, nor any other month other than this month. i.e. Ramadhan.**

(4) 1020- **Hasan li ghayrihi**

On the authority of Ibn Abbās (radiallāh hu ʿanhu):

**That the Prophet (i·ṣ) never aspired for the excellence of a day after Ramadhan, except the day of Āshār.**

Narrated by Tabarāni in al-Awasat, and its isnād is hasan with the isnād before it

(5) 1021 **Sahāh li ghayrihi**

On the authority of Abu Saād al-Khudri (radiallāh hu ʿanhu), who said that the Messenger of Allāh (i·ṣ) said: **Whoever fasts the day of Arafāt, he is forgiven for the following year and the previous year. And whoever fasts Āshār, then he is forgiven the year.**

Narrated by Tabarāni with an isnād that is Hasan.

The day of Āshār is the tenth day of Muharram
