The Book of Fasting

Chapter to Fast the Day of â€™ shâ€™râ€™

(1) â€™ 1017 â€™ Sahâ€™h

On the Authority of Abu Qatâ€™ da (radhiallâ€™ hu â€™ anhu): That the Messenger of Allâ€™ h (ï•) was asked about the fast of the day of â€™ shâ€™râ€™ , so he answered: â€™ **It expiates the sins of the previous year.**â€™

Narrated by Muslim and other than him, and by Ibn Mâ€™ jah and his wording is: â€™ **The fast of the day of â€™ shâ€™râ€™ ; Indeed the reward that I request from Allâ€™ h is that He expiates the sins of the year before this year.**â€™

(2) â€™ 1018 â€™ Sahâ€™h

On the authority of Ibn â€™ Abbâ€™ s (radhiallâ€™ hu â€™ anhu): **That the Messenger of Allaah (ï•) fasted the day of â€™ shâ€™râ€™ , and he ordered for it to be**

fasted.

Narrated by Bukhārī and Muslim

(3) 1019 **Sahāh**

On the authority of Ibn Abbās (radhiAllahu anhu), who was asked about the fast of the day of Ash'ra, so he answered: **I do not know of the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) fasting a day, wanting the excellence of that fast above that of other days, nor any other month other than this month. i.e. Ramadhān.**

(4) 1020- **Hasan li ghayrihi**

On the authority of Ibn Abbās (radhiAllahu anhu):

That the Prophet (ﷺ) never aspired for the excellence of a day after Ramadhān, except the day of Ash'ra.

Narrated by Tabarāni in al-Awasat, and its isnād is hasan with the isnād before it

(5) 1021 **Sahāh li ghayrihi**

On the authority of Abu Sa'ād al-Khudri (radhiAllahu anhu), who said that the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said: **Whoever fasts the day of Arafāt, he is forgiven for the following year and the previous year. And whoever fasts Ash'ra, then he is forgiven the year.**

Narrated by Tabarāni with an isnād that is Hasan.

The day of Ash'ra is the tenth day of Muharram

All praise belongs to Allah; may His peace and blessings be upon our final Prophet Muhammad, his family, his companions, and all those who follow his guidance.
