lmaam At tirmidhi mentions his chain of narration going back to Ibn Abaas â∏ Radhiyallahu â∏ Anhumaa who said: â∏ The Jews came to the Messenger of Allah and they said â∏ <i>Oh Abal Qaassim! Inform us about thunder what is it?</i> He replied:
â An Angel from the angels who is responsible for the clouds, he has with hin bolts of fire that he drives the clouds with wherever he willsâ so they said: â So what is this noise we hear (i.e. thunder)? He replied: â It is him rebuking them as he drives them, so as to cause them to arrive at the goal he intends (fo them)â (in a variant version it mentions that his response was: â It is his voiceâ) so they responded: â You have spoken the truth!â □
