Imaam At tirmidhi mentions his chain of narration going back to Ibn Abaas â€“ Radhiyallahu â€“ Anhumaa who said: â€“ The Jews came to the Messenger of Allah and they said â€“ *Oh Abal Qaassim! Inform us about thunder what is it?* He replied:

â€“ ***An Angel from the angels who is responsible for the clouds, he has with him bolts of fire that he drives the clouds with wherever he willsâ€“*** so they said: â€“ *So what is this noise we hear (i.e. thunder)?* He replied: â€“ ***It is him rebuking them as he drives them, so as to cause them to arrive at the goal he intends (for them)***â€“ (in a variant version it mentions that his response was: â€“ ***It is his voiceâ€“***) so they responded: â€“ *You have spoken the truth!..â€“*
