



Hadith on the Islamic Understanding of Thunder

Bismillahi Wal Hamdullillah Was Salaatu Was Salaamu â€‹ Alaa Rasoolillahi

Imaam At tirmidhi mentions his chain of narration going back to Ibn Abaas â€‹ Radhiyallahu â€‹ Anhumaa who said: â€‹ The Jews came to the Messenger of Allah and they said â€‹ *Oh Abal Qaassim! Inform us about thunder what is it?* He replied:

â€‹ **An Angel from the angels who is responsible for the clouds, he has with him bolts of fire that he drives the clouds with wherever he wills**â€‹ so they said: â€‹ *So what is this noise we hear (i.e. thunder)?* He replied: â€‹ **It is him rebuking them as he drives them, so as to cause them to arrive at the goal he intends (for them)**â€‹ (in a variant version it mentions that his response was: â€‹ **It is his voice**â€‹) so they responded: â€‹ You have spoken the truth!..â€‹
