



Sleep in Purity, Receive Mercy: Hadith on the Virtue of Wudhu Before Sleep

Description

Bismillahi Wal Hamdullillah Was Salaatu Was Salaamu â€ Alaa Rasoolillahi

Ammaa Baâ€ d:

Upon the authority of Ibn Umar -Radhiyallahu â€ Anhumaa -who said that the Messenger â€ Sallallahu â€ Alaihi Was Salam Said:

â€ Purify these Bodies (of yours), May Allah grant you purity, for indeed there is not a servant that spends the night in a state of purification except that an angel spends the night with him in his garment. He does not turn at anytime during the night except that the angel says: â€ Oh Allah forgive your servant for indeed he spent the night in a state of purity!â€

(Collected by Imaamut Tabaraani in â€ Muâ€ jam al Kabeer (13620) and declared â€ Hasanâ€ by shaikh Al Albaani in â€ Saheehul Jaamiâ€ (3936))

Upon the authority of Ibn Umar â€ Radhiyallahu â€ Anhumaa who said that the messenger -Sallallahu â€ Alaihi Was Salam said:

â€ Whoever goes to sleep in a state of purification an angel spends the night in his garment. He doesnt wake from the night except that the angel says: â€ Oh Allah forgive your servant such and such for indeed he spent the night in a state of purityâ€

(Collected by Ibn Hibaan (1048) and Shaikh Al Albaani declared it **â** Hasanun Saheehâ **â**)

Upon the authority of Muâ **â** aadh Ibn Jabal **â** Radhiyallahu **â** Anhu **â** who narrated upon the authority of the messenger **â** Sallallahu Alaihi Was Salam **â** Who said:

â *There is no Muslim that goes to sleep with the remembrance of Allah and in a state of purity and is then startled and wakes during the night and asks Allah for the good of this world and the hereafter except that he give it to him* **â**

(Collected by Abu Daawood 5042 and declared **â** Saheehâ **â** by Shaikh Al Albaani)

(Note: The word used in the hadeeth is **â** (referring to the garment on his body as Imaam Manaawi has explained) and not **â** meaning his hair as it was previously erroneously translated)

These narrations then establish the following:

1. The Dua of the angel for the servant as he stirs and moves during his sleep
2. The Dua of the angel for him when he wakes after the night from his sleep
3. His Dua being accepted if he supplicates for the good of the dunya and the hereafter when he is startled during the night, if he sleeps upon the remembrance of Allah and in a state of purification.
