## His Encounter with al-MaʾmÅ«n

ʿAbd al-RazzÄ□ q ibn SulaymÄ□ n ibn Ê¿AlÄ« ibn al-JaÊ¿d narrated:

â $\square$  I heard my father say: Al-Maʳ¼mÅ«n once summoned jewel merchants and engaged them in a discussion about their goods. After a while, he left to attend to some business and then returned. When he entered, everyone in the gathering stood up for himâ $\square$  except for ʿAlÄ« ibn al-JaÊ¿d.â $\square$ 

Al-MaʾmÅ«n **looked at him with displeasure**, then signalled for him to meet him in private.

He asked:  $\hat{a} \square$  O Shaykh, what prevented you from standing? $\hat{a} \square$ 

ʿAlÄ« ibn al-JaÊ¿d replied:

 $\hat{a} \square$  O Commander of the believers, I refrained from standing **out of reverence for a** hadith that we narrate from the Prophet  $i \cdot o \cdot \hat{a} \square$ 

Al-Ma $\hat{E}_{4}$ mūn asked:  $\hat{a}$  And what is that hadith? $\hat{a}$ 

He responded:

Hearing this, al-Maê¾mÅ«n fell silent in contemplation. Then he raised his head and declared:
â∏ No purchases should be made except from this man!â∏
That day, they bought from him thirty thousand dinarsâ∏ worth of goods!.
