| Since todays (11/3/2013) lesson in tafseer has been cancelled, I mention here some brief benefits related to last weeks lesson that were not discussed due to time constraints . |
| Allah the most high says:  |
| â ☐ Oh Children of Israaâ ☐ eel remember the blessings I bestowed upon youâ ☐ (Suratul Baqarah Vs 40)  |
| Imaam Ibn Katheer mentions (1/151) with a chain of narration going back to Ibn Abaas that:   |
| â∏ (The name) Israaâ∏ eel is like your statement â∏ Abdullahâ∏   |
| Imaam Abd Ibn Humaid mentions with a chain of narration going back to Ibn masâ $\  \  \  \  \  \  \  \  \  \  \  \  \  $   |
| â∏ Ilyaas is (another name for) Idrees, and Yaâ∏ qoob is Israaâ∏ eelâ∏   |
| Allah the most high states:  |
| â <b>∏ And fear none but me</b> â <b>∏</b> (Vs 40)   |



| Ibn Abbaas said:   |
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| $\hat{a} \square$ Lest there come upon you that which befell your forefathers of Allahs wrath and retribution, mutation being from that (Allah transformed some of them into Pigs and Monkeys as a punishment upon them) $\hat{a} \square$   |
| Allah the most high mentions:  |
| $\hat{a}_{\square}$ And believe in what I have sent down (This qur $\hat{a}_{\square}$ aan) confirming that which is with you and be not the first to disbelieve therein $\hat{a}_{\square}$ (Suratul Baqarah Vs 41)   |
| Imaam At tirmidhi mentions his chain of narration going back to Ibn Abaas who said: $\hat{a} \square$ The Jews came to the Messenger of Allah and they said $\hat{a} \square$ Oh Abal Qaassim! Inform us about thunder what is it? He replyed:   |
| An Angel from the angels who is responsible for the clouds, he has with him bolts of fire that he drives the clouds with wherever he willsâ so they said: â So what is this noise we hear (i.e. thunder)? He replied: â It is him rebuking them as he drives them, so as to cause them to arrive at the goal he intends (for them)â (in a variant version it mentions that his response was: â It is his voiceâ ) so they responded: â You have spoken the truth!â |
| So they asked him: â Then inform us what it was that Israaâ eel made prohibited upon himself? (a reference to the statement of Allah the most high: â All food was lawful for the children of Israaâ eel other than what Israaâ eel made unlawful for himself before the taurah was revealed (Surah Aali Imraan Vs 93) he responded:   |
| â He was suffering from sciatica and there was nothing he could find reponsible for it other than him consuming camels meat and camels milk, for this reason he made it prohibited upon himselfâ they said: â You have spoken the truth!â  |

| Indicating that which the lews were upon from rejection of the truth   |
