**Benefit**: This hadeeth points towards a position held by some of the people of knowledge (from them Al Imaam Al Bukhaari) that the Hawd will be after the Siraat.



Also, the scholars who have explained the hadeeth, mention that the fact the Prophet â
to find him on the day of judgement does not indicate that this is the order in which these
things will occur, since the well-known order is the Hawd, then the reckoning in the presence of the scales and then the siraat.
